MACROSCOPIC DESCRIPTION

Rosso Damasco is an intense red marble, crossed by white and dark veins with yellow shades. Yellow veins, associated with intense color, give the material a warm and unhealthy appearance. The lithotype in question is fine grain, veined and compact.

The conditions in which Rosso Damasco marble is formed makes it one of the favorite materials for Greek and Roman sculptors and architects, leading it to be a symbol of taste and tradition. Even the fact of being able to count on colorful and varied models makes Red Damascus one of the favorite decorative materials.
